Decer Constituent,

Thank you for contacting me about the supply of cluster ammunition to Ukraine.

The UK is a signatory to The Convention on Cluster Munitions (CCM) and enacted the Cluster Munitions (Prohibitions) Act 2010 which includes legal sanctions as required by the CCM. As a State Party to the CCM, the UK completed destruction of its cluster munition stockpiles in December 2013 and is prohibited from transferring cluster munitions.

I agree with the Prime Minister when he stated that as a "signatory to a convention which prohibits the production or use of cluster munitions we discourage their use".

The UK has called on any states not already party to the Convention on Cluster Munitions to accede without delay. The UK has made a number of statements in support of the Convention and its comprehensive ban on cluster munitions, including at the UN General Assembly.
